- ☞ Open to persons 60 years of age or older.
- ☞ Rides offered on a space availability basis.
- ☞ No one is denied a ride due to the inability to pay the full fare. Please contact Rita in the Five Cities office for assistance: (763) 531-1274.

Fare Information:

- ☞ **Regular Destination Fare:** \$3 per round trip with the convenient pass card or \$4 cash.
- ☞ **Special Destination Fare:** The round trip special fare is \$7 cash or 2 punches from a pass card (\$6) A minimum of 15 riders are needed to for these destinations and will be noted in this schedule.
- ☞ **Pass cards:** Available for regular and special destinations in \$14 or \$28 amounts and may be purchased from the driver with cash or check payable to: First Transit Company.

Reservations: Riders may reserve as many rides as they wish for October unless otherwise noted in the schedule. For September, reservations may be made beginning the last week in October.

- ☞ **Home Pickup** reservations must be made a minimum of two working days in advance.
- ☞ **Apartment Pickup** reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance.
- ☞ If an emergency occurs and you cannot take the bus, PLEASE CALL!

Rider Assistance Policy: Five Cities drivers will assist you boarding or exiting the bus. If you want assistance **WAIT** for the driver to help you. You may need to allow riders who do not want assistance to board or exit before you receive help. Ask the driver or signal that you would like assistance. **WAIT** until the driver has exited the bus and is standing by the door. A passenger lift is available if the stairs are difficult for you.

Rider Fare Notice:

Drivers will accept your fare or punch your pass only after you have completed boarding the bus. Do not attempt to pay the driver while you are on the stairs.
